



GREGORY C. DEVEREAUX

Mr. Devereaux has been in state and local government for more than 30 years, serving in various capacities including Acting Director of Parks and Recreation for the City of Long Beach; Director of Community Development and Housing and Neighborhood Development for the City of Garden Grove, California.; and from 1993 to 1997, he was City Manager of Fontana, California. During his tenure, he stabilized the city's finances, increased infrastructure maintenance, and restored community programs.

In September 1997, Mr. Devereaux became City Manager for the City of Ontario, California. Working closely with the Mayor and City Council, the city embarked on an aggressive program to grow the city's economy and restructure the city's staff to better serve its residents and the business community. Those years since September 1997 resulted in substantial surpluses allowing the city to build reserves, fund unfunded liabilities, and undertake the most aggressive investment in community facilities in the city's history. Mr. Devereaux became County Administrative Officer for the County of San Bernardino, California in February 2010. He retired from this position in June of 2017.

Mr. Devereaux is a Board Member and Past President of the California Redevelopment Association and on multiple California League of Cities committees. He is on the advisory committee for the Keston Institute for Public Finance and Infrastructure Policy at USC, the advisory board for the Department of Public Administration, California State University, San Bernardino, and is the "visiting resident" in the Eberly College of Arts and Sciences, Division of Public Administration, residency program at the West Virginia University.

He has received the James Thalman Award, Memorial Public Services Award from the League's Inland Empire Division, and was named "Management Leader of the Year" by the A. Gary Anderson Graduate School of Management at the University of California, Riverside. He was also the recipient of the Building Industry Association Baldy View Chapter – 2007 Good Government Award and the American Society for Public Administration Inland Empire Chapter – 2008 Outstanding Senior Administrator and most recently appointed by the California Air Resources Board to the Regional Targets Advisory Committee on greenhouse gas reduction under SB 375.
